Cloud height sensor



Overview

- Dutch Royal Weather Service (KNMI) and Deutscher Wetterdienst (German Weather Service, DWD)
- Timeframe 2015-2019
- Cloud height sensor capable of measurements up to an altitude of 15 kilometers
- KNMI: 50 devices on- and offshore;
 DWD: more than 100 devices



Product Scope

- Renewal and expansion of existing measurement network
- Data for customer group such as civil and military airport managers, flight weather consultants, users of environmental measurement technology, climate researchers
- Research on atmospheric particle distribution
- Determination of mixing layer depths
- Optimization of weather forecast models



PROJECT 5

Urban flood warning: Hurricane Harvey





Harris County, TX, USA



Overview

- Harris County Flood Control District partnered with OTT HydroMet to expand network
- 22 watersheds and 1500 miles of open channel drainage network
- 13 stations in 1982
- 153 stations in 2017
- 19 include OTT HydroMet RLS, 38 include OTT HydroMet CBS
- Measuring flood warning, precipitation, and water levels



Product Scope

- Expand real-time network and install sensors in creeks and bayous
- Accurate, reliable data for government authorities, the media, and the general public
- Flood warning system for emergency management authorities
- Better protection of life and property during episodic events




- OTT Radar Level Sensors (RLS) and Compact Bubble Sensors (CBS) installed
- Use non-contact measurement techniques to be unaffected by rising flood waters
- Measure water level (rate of rise) and precipitation (intensity and accumulation)
- Data transmitted in real-time to Harris County Flood Warning System website
- Fewer data gaps



PROJECT 6

Critical infrastructure monitoring: post hurricane Katrina





New Orleans, LA, USA



Overview

- Army Corps of Engineers partnered with OTT HydroMet for monitoring stations
- 17th Street, Orleans, & London Canals in New Orleans
- Started in 2006, continuing with ongoing maintenance
- 12 OTT HydroMet stations
- Water level, rain, barometric pressure, wind speed/direction, air temperature, relative humidity



Product Scope

- Need for communication redundancy and remote monitoring
- Visibility of water level conditions in New Orleans main drainage canals
- Operation of the canals
- Monitoring and operation of interim pump stations
- Monitoring and control of the pumps, gates, and structures connecting the canals to Lake Ponchatrain



- OTT HydroMet provided installation, testing, and training for 12 new water monitoring stations, plus battery and solar power for equipment and fiber converters
- Xpert dataloggers support redundancy and varied data collection intervals through multiple communication paths:
 - Fiber-Optic cable
 - GOES satellite
 - Idirium satellite


